

SPECIAL DAYS

1. **PARTIES**

There are parties for the children marking special days during the school year: Halloween, Thanksgiving, Christmas, Valentine's Day, and Easter. These parties are designed to be "fun experiences" for the children. Details of these events are coordinated by the party mom and teacher.

2. **BIRTHDAYS**

It has been the practice to mark a child's birthday in some special way, if the parents so desire. The parent provides a simple treat for the occasion. Check with the teacher for suggestions. Let the scheduling mom and the teacher know when you will celebrate your child's birthday. If a child's birthday is in the summer, a half birthday may be celebrated.

3. **SPECIAL GUEST NIGHT**

Because most fathers would find it impossible to share in the preschool experience during the regular working hours, each group has a special session to which fathers are invited. If the father is not available, a grandparent or other special adult may attend. The children really enjoy bringing their special guest to school. This evening session takes the place of the regular daytime session.
